

Traffic Safety Pictionary

Overview:

Knowing how to maintain one's vehicle is of the utmost importance when following traffic safety precautions. Most modern cars are equipped with warning signals that alert the driver in the event of the vehicle's compromise, known as dashboard lights. A situation may also arise where an unforeseen obstacle presents itself along the driver's route. Oftentimes, drivers are made aware of these obstacles by yellow warning signs with various symbols that can represent a myriad of possible dangers on the road.

Rules:

Clients will separate themselves into 5 groups. At the start of both rounds, each group will designate one member to be the "artist". This person will arrive at the board and be given a set of images to draw. While they are drawing, members of their team will call out the name of the symbol they believe their teammate is attempting to illustrate. Upon completion of both rounds, incorrect responses will be tallied and a final time will be calculated. The winning team receives a prize at the discretion of the instructor.

- Symbols must be drawn sequentially. If a group does not know the answer, they may call "pass" and have 45 seconds added to their final time.
- Each incorrect guess called by the participating team will result in 10 seconds being added to their final time.
- Only members of the participating team may call out guesses. The artist cannot talk.
- Only words and letters that appear on the original symbol may be written by the artist.
